

# THE HOPE CENTER REACHED NEW MILESTONES IN 2022!

- Distributed 201,703 pounds of food and household items -Over 35,000 pounds was fresh produce.
  - Over 5,800 volunteer hours

  - 9,168 grocery bags were given away.
    - 14,556 individuals were served.




## Thank You to our Beneficiaries!

Park View Box Hill

Most residents living at Park View Box Hill have one income; Social Security. Each day many experience financial challenges that make it difficult to stretch their dollars to reach the end of the month. The HOPE Center has been the solution to this problem. Each month The HOPE Center hosts a free shopping experience to all residents. This allows them to fill empty cupboards with basic food pantry items to fresh produce (when in season), paper good items and laundry detergent. Volunteers from The HOPE Center frequently engaged in friendly conversation with lonely residents. The residents look forward to The HOPE Center's arrival every month. In addition to this, food items are donated for meals provided to residents who are ill or over 90 yrs. old and not able to cook each day.

## HANDS for HOPE: Senior Food Distribution Services

As the cost of basic necessities continues to rise, individuals and families in Harford County are struggling to keep up. The situation is particularly difficult for seniors, thus, to help our elderly neighbors, The HOPE Center of Maryland has launched HANDS for HOPE. Through HANDS for HOPE, The HOPE Center currently provides to residents of several senior housing facilities, including Park View Bel Air, Park View Box Hill, Catholic Charities/Aberdeen Courts.
