### Making a Difference

Child hunger is a reality in Harford County, Maryland. Weekend meal programs help fill the hunger gap that many schoolchildren experience when they are not in school. Through our Beyond Blessings program, The HOPE Center of Maryland provides students in high-poverty area public schools with bags of kid-friendly, nutritious food to sustain them on weekends when free school meals are not available.

Beyond Blessings is designed for elementary and middle school students. The bags are delivered to the schools where social workers distribute them to the students with the highest need. For the current school year, The HOPE Center of Maryland will provide 100-weekend meal bags to at-risk children attending Bakerfield and Deerfield Elementary Schools and Edgewood Middle School. That comes to 4,400 meal bags or 26,400 meals provided.

We are reaching out to the community for monetary contributions and food collection drives on behalf of The HOPE Center.

### *Senior Food Distribution Services*

As the cost of basic necessities continues to rise, individuals and families in Harford County are struggling to keep up. The situation is particularly difficult for seniors in our community. Through HANDS for HOPE, The HOPE Center currently provides to residents of several senior housing facilities, including Park View Bel Air, Aberdeen Courts, and Park View Box Hill. These monthly "shopping days" supply seniors with food supplies, as well as a chance for friendship and fellowship. Also, The HOPE Center drops off additional foods when donated during the month such as fresh produce (when in season) and Wawa sandwiches and pastries.
