Don't think you'd have enough to donate? Consider teaming up with your neighbor gardeners to make donations. You CAN make a difference!

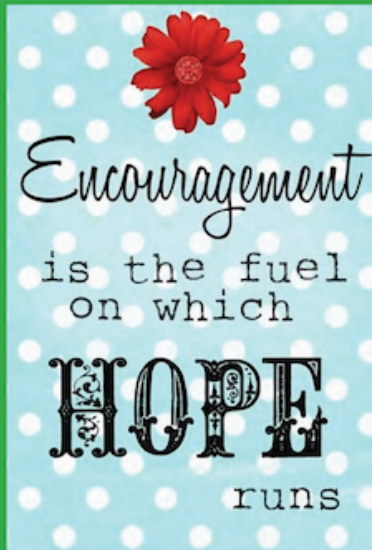

As the cost of basic necessities continues to rise, individuals and families in Harford County are struggling to keep up. The situation is particularly difficult for seniors in our community. Through HANDS for HOPE, The HOPE Center currently provides to residents of several senior housing facilities, including Park View Bel Air, Aberdeen Courts, Park View Box Hill, and Abingdon Gardens. These monthly "shopping days" supply seniors with food supplies, as well as a chance for friendship and fellowship.
