



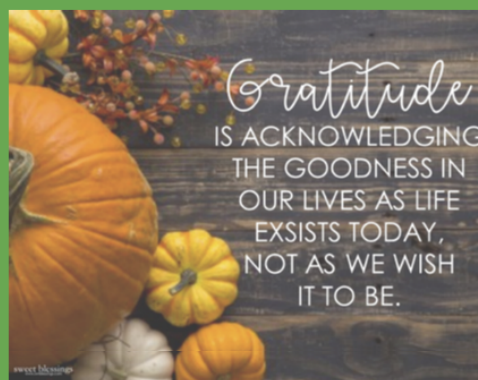


## Who We Are
